NOTES TO PARENTS

By enrolling your child(ren) in the Yorkland Aquatics Program, you agree to the following in order to help us maintain a safe and pleasant environment for all involved in the swimming program.

- Change room policy – Children 5 years and older are not permitted to enter the change room of the opposite sex, either to change themselves or to assist a sibling. Parents may never enter the change room of the opposite sex.
- It is very important that you supervise your children at all times, particularly those who are waiting for their lessons or brothers and sisters that come with swimmers. Please ensure that your children are with you and do not remain unattended.
- During the hours designated for swimming lessons the gym is not available to parents or children.
- We would also ask you to refrain from eating and/or drinking in the hallways, the change rooms and the pool viewing area.
- No credits or refunds will be given once a session has started. If you do need to cancel your registration, it must be done at least one week prior to the start of the session.
- No videotaping or still photography of the pool area is permitted at any time.

YORKLAND AQUATICS SPRING 2010 ADVANCED AWARDS

BRONZE MEDALLION

Bronze Medallion teaches young and adult life savers alike how to respond in complex water rescue situations. Bronze Medallion develops physical fitness, decision making, and judgement skills. Rescuers learn both tows and carries, and release methods in preparation for challenging rescues of increased risk. Life savers develop stroke efficiency and endurance in a timed swim. Bronze Medallion is a prerequisite for all advanced life saving awards. We require a minimum of 4 students to offer this course. Total course time -- 24 hours. This course includes certification in Emergency First Aid (EFA). A written test is required for certification in EFA. Cost for writing the test once is included in the course, a second attempt if the student fails will cost an additional \$10.00

- COST:** \$195.00
PURPOSE: To emphasize the life saving principles of the practical items in this award.
PREREQUISITES: Minimum age-13 years on the exam date. (Completion of SK 12 is recommended).
CLASS LENGTH: Classes will be held on four Saturdays from 1:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. The class will go until 8:00 p.m. on the day of the exam.
EVALUATION: All candidates will be examined by their Lifesaving Society of Canada (LSSC) Instructor as well as a LSSC Examiner.
CERTIFICATION: Colourful crest, certification card, and bronze medal.
CLASS DATES: May 1, 8, 15 and June 5. (*Exam date –June 5*)

BRONZE CROSS

Bronze Cross is designed for life savers who want the challenge of more advanced training including an introduction to safe supervision in aquatic facilities. Bronze Cross teaches the difference between life saving and life guarding, the principles of emergency procedures, team work, and use of special equipment. Bronze Cross is a prerequisite for life guarding training in the National Lifeguard Service (NLS) program. We require a minimum of 4 students to offer this course. Total course time -- 24 hours.

- COST:** \$195.00
PURPOSE: To emphasize the life saving principles of the practical items in this award.
PREREQUISITES: Candidate must be 14 years of age on the exam date and have their Bronze Medallion.
CLASS LENGTH: Classes will be held on four Saturdays from 1:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. The class will go until 8:00 p.m. on the day of the exam.
EVALUATION: All candidates will be examined by their LSSC Instructor as well as a LSSC Examiner.
CERTIFICATION: Colourful crest, certification card, and bronze cross medal.
CLASS DATES: May 1, 8, 15 and June 5. (*Exam date –June 5*)

Class space for the Bronze Medallion and Bronze Cross classes will be limited to a combined maximum of 20 students. Register early to avoid disappointment!
