## YORKLAND AQUATICS SUMMER 2010 NATIONAL LIFE SAVING (NLS) and STANDARD FIRST AID (SFA) COURSE INFORMATION

**National Life Saving:** Learn the fundamentals of life guarding and swimming pool operation. Topics include scanning and rescue procedures, preventative life guarding, public relations, emergency response, First Aid and pool maintenance. Candidates are reminded that Bronze Cross and Emergency First Aid are prerequisites for this course. This course is combined with Standard First Aid. Candidates must be 16 years of age by the date of the exam.

**Standard First Aid:** Includes CPR-C certification (Adult, Child and Infant). Standard First Aid provides comprehensive training covering all aspects of first aid and CPR. Standard First Aid incorporates all of Emergency First Aid (done with Bronze Medallion) and is designed for those who require a more in depth understanding of first aid including: legal implications of first aid treatment, spinal injuries, heat and cold injuries, bone and joint injuries, abdominal and chest injuries, burns, and medical emergencies. This course is combined with the National Lifesaving certification. \*\*\* Please note that if students currently hold a valid SFA Certificate they will still need to be able to demonstrate the skills during this course as they will be tested on them.
